2006 Consultation EQF

Government's decision to implement a NQF in Austria

 Working groups were set up to prepare a NQF



2007 Surveys & Analysis

- National steering group was established
- First "fact-finding phase"
- Information and public awareness work
- Analysis by ordering diverse studies
- Preparing a consultation paper



2008 Consultation process NQF

- All stakeholders were involved
- Commentaries' evaluation by experts
- Report to the national steering group
- Presentation of the conclusions and recommendations



2009 Analysis of consultation – Council of Ministers

Preparation of a **policy paper** of both ministries (BMWF & BMUKK) involved to devise the strategy for the Austrian NQF implementation



Principles NQF Austria

- 8 level structure
- Orientation and communication function
- Learning outcome orientation of the modules in HE
- Integration of formal, non-formal and informal learning
- Dublin descriptors for level 6-8 of Bologna qualifications



Development since 2010 2010

- Development criteria and process of allocation of non-HEqualifications to NQF (C 1)
- Establishment of a NCP for NQF as a communication platform



Development since 2010 2011

- Start of phase of simulation of allocation of selected non-HEqualifications
- Test of critical parts of process of allocation
- Peer learning activity for the steering committee
